

#### PATIENT INFORMATION

Patients receive care and instructions at the ID Care's Office Infusion Center (OIC) as an option to receiving intravenous therapies.

The OIC is conveniently located in the physician's office and patients return according to individualized treatment plans to have blood work drawn, dressings changed, and to undergo evaluation by the care team and physician. Office Infusion Center care allows patients to receive on-going medications and supplies along with treatment success.

The OIC provides privacy for the patient while allowing the nurse to observe each patient during treatment. Our patients receive care in a convenient setting with comfortable recliner chairs.
